Dog First Aid List Suggestions

Listed below are suggested items that can help you be prepared for an unexpected medical situation.

- "Dog First Aid Box" (container to put these items in)
- gauze sponges
- adhesive tape
- space blanket
- wash cloth
- Benedryl caps (used for allergies, bee stings, etc.)
- peroxide
- muzzle (leash also works)
- corn syrup (used for hypoglycemia - low blood sugar; hard to keep from freezing.)
- nylon leash (also can be a muzzle)
- nail clippers
- thermometer
- rolled cohesive tape (vet wrap - 3 inch wide is ideal)
- 1 inch sticky white tape
- styptic powder (quickly stops bleeding caused by clipping nails and minor cuts)
- needle nose pliers
- small wire cutters
