Mentor Description and Requirements

Description:

By definition a mentor is, " A wise and trusted counselor or teacher." Under the Mid-Union Sled Haulers Constitution, which all members subscribe to, states under article II **Purpose**, "The purpose of this organization shall be to encourage the practice and growth of recreational sled dog activities through breeding, training, driving and racing."

Mentors shall be noted by an **M** in the membership list.

Requirements to become a Mentor:

To become a mentor, a person must be an adult level racer with five years of active experience at that level. This person must be a current member of M.U.S.H. and have been a member for the last four years. This person must have a minimum of five years of active racing/dog driving experience, but does not need to be actively racing/dog driving at the present time. A qualified member must petition the M.U.S.H. board or be asked by a M.U.S.H. Board member to become a mentor. Request to be a mentor, by a person that does not meet these requirements must be presented to the M.U.S.H. Board for consideration.
